

East Hill Cabinetry

Briarcliff Manor (December, 2010)- Custom maple cabinets with a linen paint from Mouser Custom Cabinetry with inset, shaker style doors and classic black hardware provided the kitchen with a crisp, clean look. Cabinets with antique glass surround the window, which provides beautiful views of the Hudson River. Decorative legs on the cooktop, sink, island and hutch cabinets add a sophisticated, custom detail. Other custom touches include a cutlery drawer, a spice

cabinet, tray dividers located above the double oven and pullouts in every base cabinet. All cabinet doors and drawers have self-closing slides.

An island, which seats four, holds a sink and a microwave drawer unit. Wainscot panels as well as custom shelving on the island show off the fine craftsmanship and detail of the cabinets.

"Layout was critical in the design of the kitchen" said Anthony Maucieri, President of East Hill Cabinetry. "By opening up the floor plan and centering an eat-in



table between the family room and the kitchen, we were able to create a continuous design throughout the back of the home to tie the spaces together."

Tall ceilings throughout the home created another design challenge in the kitchen. To combat the look of oversized upper cabinets, Maucieri suggested a 'stacked' cabinet with upper and lower doors. "Stacked cabinets eliminate the need for oversized cabinet doors, making the room feel much more to scale," said Maucieri.

The kitchen was completed with a hand finished, crackle tile from Rye Ridge Tile installed by Maucieri Marble and Tile, a Millennium Cream granite countertop and professional grade appliances from Viking.
